Core Activity P5: Identify and screen individuals who are at risk of SUD/ODD and make available prevention, harm reduction, early intervention services, referral to treatment and other supportive services to minimize the potential for the development of SUD/ODD.

# What's Next for Core Activity P5?

- Opportunity for cross-learning
  - Lawrence County through SPF-PFS project in SE Ohio.
  - Detera Bags
    - Universal Population: All community members
      - Community-wide distribution (for familiarity)
    - Selective Population: Those who are prescribed opioids (“higher-than-average” risk)
      - Multi-pronged Approach
        - Point of prescribing (Provider)
        - Point of sale (Pharmacist)
  - Aligning/expanding existing media campaign (underage drinking): Talk They Hear You
