#1: Develop and strengthen local consortia

- Within local communities

#2: Develop a comprehensive strategic plan for OUD prevention, treatment, recovery, and access to care

- Leveraging existing federal, state, and local OUD resources

#3: Assess needs, gap, and resources with the OUD prevention, treatment, and recovery workforces, systems, and access to care

- Focus with strategies will be on addressing gaps

- Key dissemination strategy

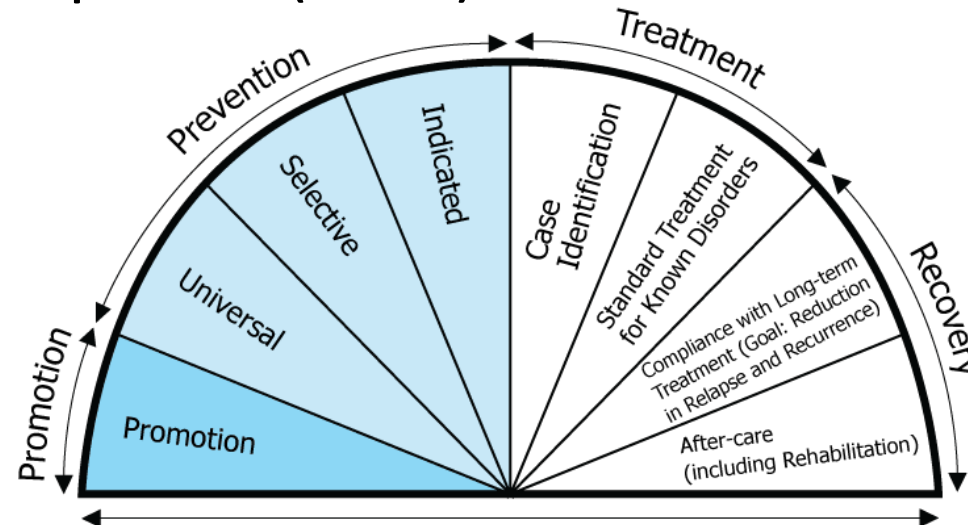
#7: Leverage existing OUD efforts and resources at the local, state, and federal levels.

Core Activity #2: Needs Assessment

- Planned approach
 - We will need to supplement with qualitative data collected through listening sessions.
 - Further explore needs, gaps, and readiness.
 - Likely 4 areas & strategic plans: prevention, treatment, recovery, and workforce development
 - Systems and access to care
- Workforce development (WFD) needs
